The Priory School was awarded Teaching School status from September 2012. Teaching schools play a leading role in the training and professional development of teachers, support staff and headteachers, as well as contributing to the raising of standards through school-to-school support.

Collaboration is at the heart of the teaching school model. All teaching schools will be expected to work with a number of schools and other strategic partners to form a teaching school alliance. The alliance will deliver support for other schools in their wider network to:

- Play a greater role in recruiting and training new entrants to the profession (initial teacher training)
- Lead peer-to-peer professional and leadership development (continuing professional development)
- Identify and develop leadership potential (succession planning and talent management)
- Provide support for other schools
- Designate and broker SLEs
- Engage in research and development activity
