

Exams Information

Headteacher, Mark Cooper, praised the efforts of staff and students on their results in the summer of 2019.

The key figures were as follows:

KS4 – The schools progress 8 figure for 2019 is anticipated to be -0.16. The school's Attainment 8 average score was 43.7. 57.3% of pupils achieved a standard pass (grade 4 or better) in both English and Maths, with 31.5% achieving a strong pass in both (grade 5 or better). 33% of pupils achieved the English Baccalaureate with standard passes in English and Maths, demonstrating strong performance across a suite of academic subjects, including a Modern Foreign Language. The EBacc. Average Points Score was 3.83. In addition: 54.5% of pupils achieved 5 or more standard passes including English and Maths. 28.6% of pupils achieved 5 or more strong passes including English and Maths. 97% of pupils achieved 5 or more passes. 95% of students remain in education or enter into employment.
