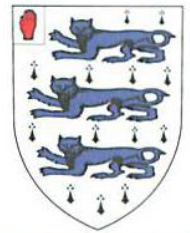

Dear Parents/Carers

EU Settlement Status

As you are probably aware, the Brexit transition period is due to end on 31st December 2020. I am writing to remind you that, for citizens of the European Union (except Ireland), Switzerland, Iceland and Liechtenstein, permission will be required to stay and work in the UK after 30th June 2021.

We know that some of our students and their families will be affected by this change of arrangements and if you are affected, we are keen to ensure you are able to make the necessary arrangements in plenty of time. The deadline for applications for settled status is 30th June 2021.
