#### Headline Information

- The percentage of school leavers meeting the duty to participation (in full time education, training, apprenticeships and full time employment with education) has continues to remain higher than the county and national average.
- The vast majority of our students continue on to full time education and attend a range of Post 16 providers (above county and national average over the past four years).
- The percentage of students who go on to participate on apprenticeships schemes in 2021 has continued to fall, however, we are still above the county and national average.
- The schools NEET percentage (those students not in education, employment of training) has been consistently below the county and national average (and falling over the past three years) suggesting that students are well informed and make appropriate choices.
