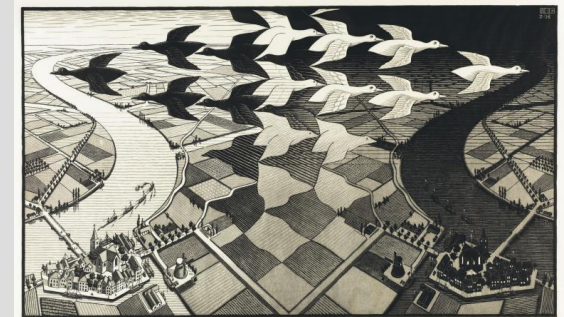

- In preparation for the course we would like you to take some photographs and create a mood board based on the theme Metamorphosis.

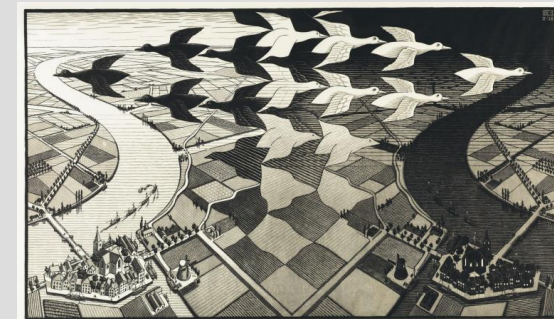






# MOOD BOARD – COLLAGE OF IMAGES

# PHOTOGRAPHY



- We would you like you take and select 40 of your favourite photographs of the following objects:
- Natural forms in peak and decaying – rose take photos as it dries out.
- Fruit/Vegetables cross section – cabbage
- Portraits of people all ages – young to old.
- Figures in different positions.
- Insects, butterflies, animals.
- Architecture – derelict, windows, door ways and stone masonry.
- Mechanical forms
- Skulls, trees – roots, shells, bones and every day objects create your own still life.
- These photos must be printed out professionally some in black and white and some in colour, these need to be saved on a USB for future Photoshop work.
