

# Transition work – Drama A level

An appreciation and understanding of live theatre is essential to your Drama A level. Over summer, try to watch a piece of live theatre. It can be local, professional, Am. Dram, of any genre or type. If you really struggle to watch a live performance as an audience member, you can use the National Theatre Live account (at the bottom of the page).

As you watch, make notes on the production. What is the staging/set like and how does it add to the performance? Which actors particularly stood out to you? Were there any bits of the production that really engaged you? How did lighting and sound add to this as well?

Bring in your notes on your chosen production, with the director, writer of the script, and production team names noted, as well as the date you watched it, and the theatre you watched it in.

Try to comment on your opinion - what really worked to help you enjoy and understand the play? What elements do you think didn't work as well? Be prepared to feedback to the group about the production you saw.
