

Exams Information 2022 Provisional Results

Headteacher, Mark Cooper, praised the efforts of staff and students on their results in the summer of 2022.

The key figures were as follows:

Key Stage 4 Results 2022

The schools progress 8 figure for 2022 is anticipated to be -0.11.

The school's Attainment 8 average score was 50.53.

70.6% of pupils achieved a standard pass (grade 4 or better) in both English and Maths, with 44.9% achieving a strong pass (grade 5 or better) in both English and Maths.

33.7% of pupils achieved the English Baccalaureate with standard passes in English and Maths, demonstrating strong performance across a suite of academic subjects, including a Modern Foreign Language.

The EBacc. Average Points Score was 4.43.

In addition: 66.3% of pupils achieved 5 or more standard passes including English and Maths. 43.3% of pupils achieved 5 or more strong passes including English and Maths.

95% of students remain in education or enter into employment.

A Level and BTEC Level 3 Results:

KS5 – 2022 Average Points Score per entry (all level 3 qualifications) = 37.02 (B-)

Average Points Score for a student's best 3 A Levels = 36.98 (B-)

A Level and BTEC Equivalent Grades:

29.1% of grades were A* – A.
