

Statement of Intent

Clearly the wearing of our uniform is a requirement of attending Thomas Adams School. We believe it allows students to gain a sense of equality, community, and identity and adhering to the uniform policy prepares students for the world of work. We would ask as parents/carers, that you support us on this issue and ensure that your child(ren) is appropriately dressed for school in the correct uniform.

We believe firmly that if our students are smartly dressed for school in a uniform consistent with school policy, they will be prepared for work in the classroom. The uniform also provides a sensible, practical and safe form of dress for school, and helps to establish a positive image of the school in the wider community. As ever, your full support in this matter is appreciated.

It is gratifying that the vast majority of students wear our uniform with pride, but we would like to draw your attention to the following:

Hooded tops, tech fleeces or cardigans should **not** be worn as a substitute for an outdoor coat or school neck jumper (which is optional). We would ask you not to buy such items for school, as your child will be asked to remove them.

School shoes for all pupils should be plain black leather or leather-like material with no motifs. Boots of any kind, including Timberlands and Doc Martins, are NOT acceptable unless we experience extreme weather conditions (snow), in which case we would expect school shoes to be carried in bags and for students to change into these on entering the building. Trainers and pumps are also unacceptable.

The rest of the Uniform Policy is below. Please take the time to study it so that you do not purchase items which are unacceptable for school. Some of these items can be expensive so please be careful not to buy anything that the school would consider unsuitable.

A reminder that facial piercings, tattoos and extreme haircuts, including unnatural colours, are not permitted.

All clothing and other personal belongings must be **CLEARLY MARKED** with the **OWNER'S NAME**.

When a student has a relevant protected characteristic as outlined in the 2010 Equality Act consideration may be given to variation in uniform after consultation with all relevant parties.

EVERYDAY UNIFORM - ALL YEAR GROUPS

Thomas Adams Blazer

Thomas Adams V-neck Jumper (optional)

White collared shirt (short or long sleeved)

Charcoal grey straight-leg trousers

Approved School Skirt (available from School Shop)

Knee length charcoal grey city shorts

Black leather/leather like shoes (no logos, no motifs, no boots, trainers or pumps)

Thomas Adams House tie (house colours)

Grey or black socks (below the knee)

Outdoor coat (optional)

Jewellery

Students are not allowed to wear any jewellery which is a risk to health and safety, e.g. tongue piercings, eyebrow rings and bars, nose studs or other piercings. Large dangly earrings, heavy rings etc are also not allowed. Any bangles/ necklaces should be out of sight. No silicone tunnels, stretchers or plug style earrings are permitted.

Hair Styles

It is expected that all students will wear their hair appropriately to reflect a serious learning environment. "Exaggerated" hairstyles and colours which are not natural are not acceptable, neither are bandanas. Any all over short hair must not be below a grade 2 and any lines cut into the style are also not acceptable.

Nails

Due to both practicality and health and safety reasons, pupils' nails should not be excessively long. Nails should end just above the end of the finger. Any pupil with excessively impractical nails will be asked to remove these (if false) or cut them to a reasonable length. As acrylic nails are expensive, we advise that, if you allow your child to have these, they do not extend beyond the end of your child's finger to avoid having to take these off or cut them.

Tattoos

These are not allowed.

Blue football socks for football only, can wear white ankle socks otherwise

Students are required to wear shin guards for their own safety during team contact sports

Mouth guard

Bands for long hair.
