Notes for students:

- **Exams start at 09.00 and 12.45.** Examinations will take place in Stanier Hall/D4 (please see your personalised timetable for details). Please meet on the Sixth Form car park 10 minutes before the exam start time. The normal timetable will collapse for this period.
- HSC external exams scheduled as indicated and take priority. Any missed internal exams will be caught up – Mrs Kinnon will advise on when/where.
- Please ensure that **equipment** is in a clear pencil case/plastic bag and calculators should have any covers/cases removed. In line with JCQ directives, **hoodies are not permitted** in the exam hall. **No food** is permitted in the examination hall – **water (only)** should be in a clear, unlabelled plastic bottle. **Mobile phones/smart-watches** should be turned off and either left in your bag or handed in at the start of the exam. JCQ examination rules state that **no watches** are permitted in the examination room - wearing any kind of watch is now considered malpractice in the same way as mobile phones, smart watches and other electronic devices. **Hand scanners are in use** to avoid potential issues with electronic devices for the benefit of all students.
