





Human Fertilization at a cellular level magnification






FERTILISATION PROCESS




Some people are unable to conceive naturally and there are other avenues that can be explored


Your teacher will go through the different ways of overcoming infertility on this slide.











According to the **NHS**

The percentage of IVF treatments that resulted in a live birth was:

- •29% for women under 35
- •23% for women aged 35 to 37
- •15% for women aged 38 to 39
- •9% for women aged 40 to 42
- •3% for women aged 43 to 44
- •2% for women aged over 44
