## Notes for students:

- **9.30 Start** – You will register as normal and go to P1 as normal. Your P1 class teacher will bring you out to the tennis courts at 9.10 where you will line up in forms before being given instructions.
- **11.40 Start** – at the end of break (11.25) you need to be at the top of the tennis courts line up in your form groups and await instructions.
- You will then be given full instructions about what is expected of you in the examination by Mr Winter, Mr McAleavy, Mr Hargreaves or Mr Allen.
- Please **bring books and equipment** for 'normal' lessons during periods 4 and 5 - period 4 will start a little late. Break, lunch and P5 will be unaffected.
- We have the **highest expectations of behaviour** in all examinations – no communicating once inside the hall until you leave the building, and you must raise your hand if you require assistance. If you are reported by an invigilator because your behaviour falls below expectation you will receive a full detention and a letter home. If this happens a second time you will receive an after-school detention. Ensure that your behaviour is perfect.
- Exams will take place in the Stanier Hall/D4. If you have extra time, a reader or a scribe then your exams will take place in a different location, and you will be informed of this beforehand.
- A **calculator** will be provided for maths and science exams ONLY. Please ensure that equipment is in a **clear pencil case/plastic bag** and calculators should have any covers/cases removed. You should write in **BLACK ink**. No food is allowed in the examination hall – water (only) should be in a clear, unlabelled plastic bottle. Mobile phones/smart-watches/watches should be turned off and left in bags OR handed in at the start of the exam. No watches are permitted in examinations rooms. Electronic scanners are in use to detect mobile phones and/or watches – these scanners are for the benefit of all students to ensure there are no disruptions in the examination rooms.
- **Toilet facilities** – please use the Stanier Hall toilets ONLY (Cadet Hut side). **Do not enter the Ruscoe/Lamont Centre.**
- Revision in preparation for your exams should be taken seriously. Your subject teachers will give you some direction on what to revise and how to revise. Learning how to revise properly/effectively will have a hugely positive effect for your future. Take the time to find out what works best.
- **Your teacher will answer subject questions.** If you have any questions regarding this timetable then see Mr Winter. It is also on the school website.
