Notes for students:

- <u>9.30 Start</u> You will register as normal and go to P1 as normal. Your P1 class teacher will bring you out to the tennis courts at 9.10 where you will line up in forms before being given instructions.

You should write in **BLACK ink**. No food is allowed in the examination hall water (only) should be in a clear, unlabelled plastic bottle. Mobile phones/smart-watches/watches should be turned off and left in bags OR handed in at the start of the exam. No watches are permitted in examinations rooms. Electronic scanners are in use to detect mobile phones and/or watches these scanners are for the benefit of all students to ensure there are no disruptions in the examination rooms.
- Toilet facilities please use the Stanier Hall toilets ONLY (Cadet Hut side). Do not enter the Ruscoe/Lamont Centre.
