- Please **bring all necessary equipment** for the exams. This includes, pens, pencils, rulers, calculators and rubbers. You should write in **BLACK ink**. A calculator will be provided for your maths and Science exams ONLY. Please ensure that **equipment is in a clear pencil case/plastic bag** and calculators should have any covers/cases removed. **No food** is permitted in the examination hall **water (only) should be in a clear, unlabelled plastic bottle**. **Mobile phones/smart-watches** should be turned off and handed in at the start of the exam (or left in your bag). **JCQ exam rules state that no watches are permitted** in the exam room whereas previously these have just been removed and placed on desks, now you MUST remove your watch before entering the room. Wearing any kind of watch is now considered malpractice in the same way as other electronic devices. **Hand scanners will be in use on entry** to the exam room for the benefit of you and everyone else in the exam room.
- If you have an entitlement to extra time/scribe etc all of your examinations will be in a separate room, and you will be advised of this beforehand.
- A list of your personal exams, timings, venues, and seating arrangements has been given to you in hard copy and email form. Please use it and keep it safe.
- We have the **highest expectations of behaviour in all examinations** you must not communicate once inside the hall until you leave the building and you must raise your hand if you require assistance from an invigilator. If are reported by an invigilator because your behaviour falls below expectation you will receive an after-school detention and a formal letter home. Please ensure that your behaviour is perfect for the benefit of everyone.
